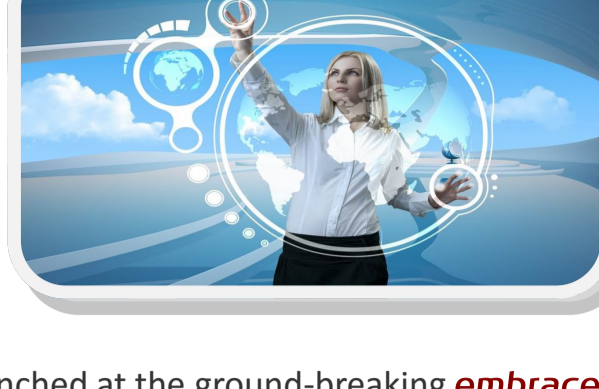

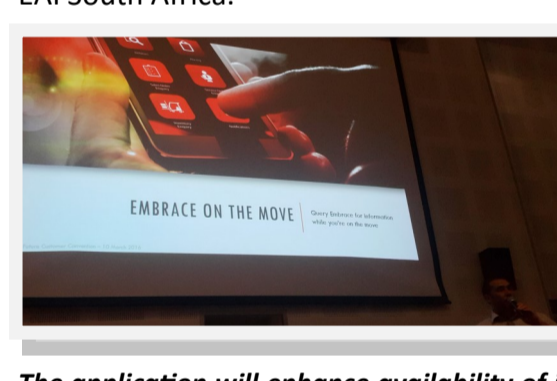

The Business of Disruption with Embrace Mobility - Francois Flamengo, CEO, EAI South Africa.



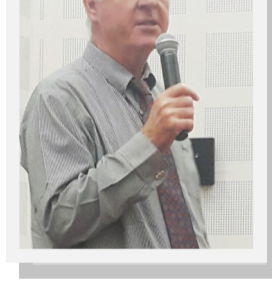
